Mr. Pearson went on to state that Tuesday morning was a difficult one when the roads were simply wet at 6:30 and the crews are on their way to work, and at 7:00 the temperature droped and everything began to freeze.

Mr. Pearson spoke briefly about his meeting with Snap-Tite regarding culvert liners. Mr. Pearson explained that the liner system is an efficient way to repair a failing tube and is being considered by MDOT for I-69. Mr. Pearson also spoke about the delivery of the concrete slab for Hollow Corners Road and the coordination with the crane for the placement. It is planned to have the bridge open before Christmas.
