Mr. Pearson stated that he has been friends with Mr. Jostock for forty plus years and he will miss him. Mr. Schons added that he worked in maintenance under Mr. Jostock for ten years and for three years as working foreman and is grateful for the knowledge he passed along to him.

Mr. Novak expressed his appreciation for what Mr. Jostock has done for the Road Commission and wished him well in his retirement.

Mr. Pearson reminded the Board of the Committee of the Whole Meeting added for September 14, 2020 to discuss the 2021 Budget. Mr. Gingell distributed maps with current PASER ratings for the Board to review prior to the meeting. Mr. Pearson stated that he is going to go forward with the projects that have Federal and State Funding.

Mr. Pearson reported the annual inventory count will take place on September 25, 2020.

Mr. Pearson explained that the road salt prices are in with pre fill at \$59.36/ton, which is \$2.47 less than last year, and back up salt is \$56.76 also down \$2.67. Mr. Pearson reported that currently the Imlay barn has 3,000 ton, Lapeer barn has 1,400 ton and the North Branch barn has 1,000 ton.

Mr. Pearson informed the Board that the hours of operation will continue on the 4 ten-hour day schedule through October, with an adjustment of starting time as it continues to stay dark later in the morning.

Superintendent Report

Mr. Schons explained that the gravel haul did not operate this week due to the holiday, but will continue next week. Mr. Schons stated the roadside mowing has moved from I-69 to the rest of the State routes.

Mr. Schons reported that the final calculations of the LCRC brining and mowing expenses resulted in a savings of \$67,044.75 to the Townships.

Mr. Schons stated that the I-69 concrete project has started today.
